Race Entry Terms and Conditions for The Lost Island Ultra - Adventure Ultra-Marathon



1. The Lost Island Ultra is owned and run by Get Lost Events Limited.
2. I have familiarised myself with the race rules and regulations of the Lost Island Ultra
3. I accept that it is my responsibility to be aware of the potentially new surrounding in which I am running/walking in
4. I am fully aware that by participating in the Lost Island Ultra there is potential risk of injury during the race
5. I fully accept that by participating in a race held in Fiji that it may involve potential risks including but not limited to: Dehydration, Sun/Heat Stroke, Exhaustion, Wild & Dangerous Animals, Objects/Obstructions, Vehicles, Inclines & Declines, Lack of Communication Methods, Failure of Personal Equipment, Risk of Getting Lost, and the Possibility of Personal Injury, Mental Trauma and Death.
6. I am aware that although the race organisers have carried out a full risk assessment of the race and its route that there may be additional/unforeseeable hazards not listed above.
7. I hereby waive, release and discharge myself and my successors (heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives etc.) any and all rights and claims which the race organiser(s), the promoter and any promoting organisation(s) and their board of directors, property owners, law enforcement agencies, all public entities, special districts, and properties (and their respective agents, officials, and employees) through or by which the event will be held for any and all damages which may be sustained by my participation in and of association with the event, or travel to or return from the event.
8. I understand that during the course of this extreme race situations and events can arise which may be beyond the control of the race organisers, officials, medical volunteers and volunteers and that if such a situation should arise I must not continue so as not to endanger myself or others.
9. I accept responsibility for the condition and adequacy of my equipment.
10. I accept responsibility for my preparation and training and current fitness levels and inherent ability to carry out the tasks set for the race each day
11. I agree, on behalf of myself and my successors, that the above terms are contractually binding, and are not mere recitals, and that should I or any of my successors assert any claim in contravention of this agreement, I or my successors shall be liable for the expenses (including legal fees) incurred by the other party or parties in defending, unless the other party or parties are finally adjusted liable on such claims for wilful or wanton negligence. This agreement may not be modified orally by either party, and a waiver of any provision shall not be construed as a modification of or as consent to any other provision herein or as a consent to any subsequent waiver of modification.
12. I have no physical or mental condition which, to my knowledge, would endanger myself or others if I participate in this event, or would interfere with my ability to participate in this event.
13. I fully understand and accept the potential risks involved in the race and I have carefully read, understand and voluntarily accept the terms of this waiver and release agreement. In addition, I agree to pay for damage caused by me to Race Organiser's equipment used in the event. I agree to abide by the rules and conditions laid down for the event and to follow instructions issued by the Race organiser(s). I understand that circumstances beyond the control of the race organiser(s) may cause the event to be modified, postponed or relocated. I accept that the organisers reserve the right to refuse entry from persons considered to have insufficient experience or disqualify those who fail to follow the rules and conditions: ignorance is no excuse. Support Entry Terms and Conditions for The Lost Island Ultra - Adventure Ultra-Marathon



1. The Lost Island Ultra is owned and run by Get Lost Events Limited.
2. I have familiarised myself with what is required of me to take a support place for the Lost Island Ultra
3. I have read the "Support Place" page on the Lost Island website and accept that I will be asked to carry out tasks that include, but are not limited to, walking up to 20km in a day, carrying heavy bags, sleeping in tents, hammocks, standing on runner check points (which may be exposed) for extended periods of time.

5. I am fully aware that by supporting the Lost Island Ultra there is potential risk of injury
